

Proposed Bylaws Amendment

Article IV 1. c. speaks of “letters of intent” as in Article III; but there is no mention of letters of intent in Article III. This amendment will add such wording.

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS, OFFICIALS AND DELEGATES

A. Party Officers. The officers of the County Party shall be the following: Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and Legislative District Chairs (Districts 71 & 73 combined). All officers of the County Party are elected for a term of two (2) years.

1. Duties of Officers.

c. Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Central Committee and the Executive Committee and shall be custodian of the minutes, files and records of each of these committees as delegated. The Secretary shall also receive letters of intent as set forth in Article III, herein, and report filings to the Executive Committee on the day following the filing deadline.

ARTICLE III REPUBLICAN PARTY DOCTRINE

C. Letter of Intent.

- (1) Republican Candidates who wish to run for County Officials or Legislators office elected at the County Party Convention must submit a letter of intent to the County Party Secretary. The letter of intent must be received by the County Party Secretary by 5: 30 PM on the filing deadline day.**
- (2) Registered Republican individual(s) desiring to run for a Party office and/or the State Central Committee must file a letter of intent with the Secretary of the Party no less than fifteen (15) days prior to the County Organizing Convention in order for his or her name to appear on the ballot.**
